## A few reminders...

**Class Curriculum News** will be sent home on **Friday** along with the new **Homework Grids** but in the meantime, here is an overview of each class topic for this term.

**Holly Class**- Childhood- It teaches children about their own school and locality both today and in the past. They compare schooling in the Victorian Era and their experiences today. Then we will be moving onto learning about Significant National/Global events including 'Dangerous Dinosaurs'.

**Oak Class**- Emperors and Empires. This project teaches children about the history and structure of ancient Rome and the Roman Empire, including a detailed exploration of the Romanisation of Britain.

**Willow Class**- Ground Breaking Greeks. This project teaches the children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.
